To Phyllis Harmon, Membership officer - the club wouldn't be the same without her.

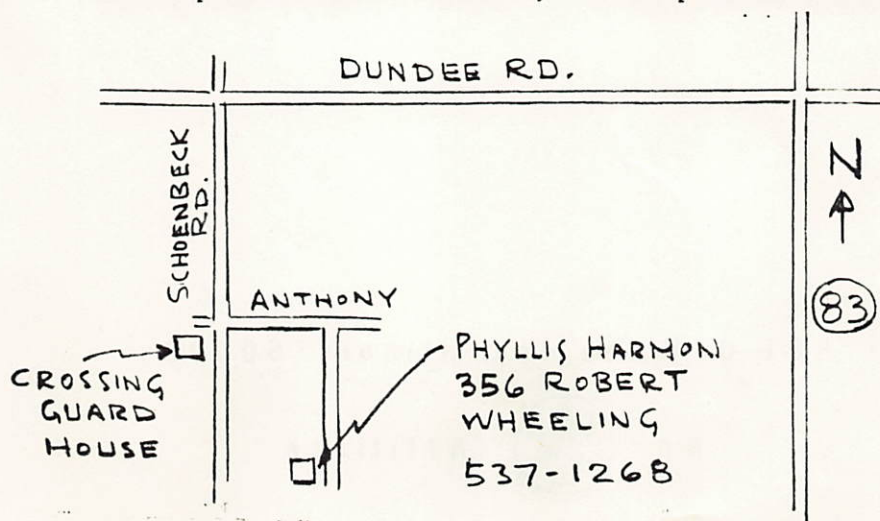
