SUMMER TOUR

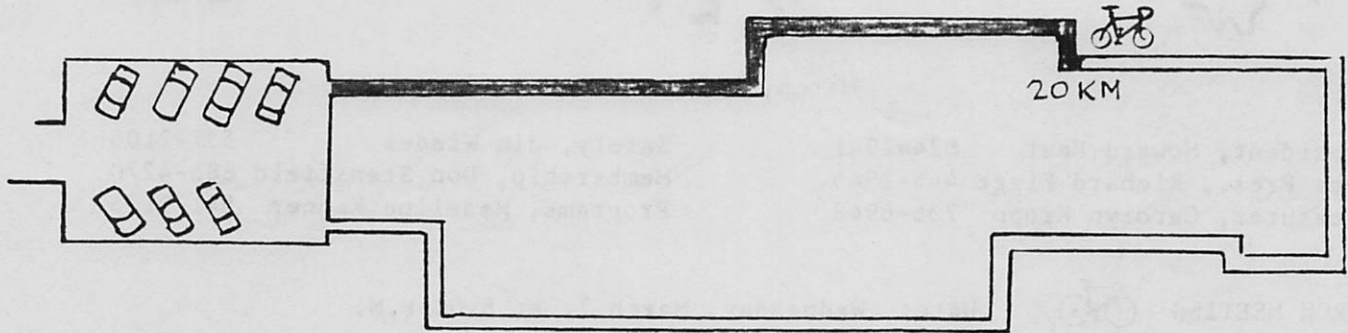

SAFETY TIP OF THE MONTH 

As you approach an intersection, be especially careful about cars on your left - either ahead or behind you - as they may turn right-into you, or ahead of you and you will hit them.

Where a cyclist joins several cars stopped for an intersection, the same caution applies. Some experienced cyclists join the cars in their lane-and move into the right side position, just after the right turn area is passed.

IMAGINE IT'S 1984



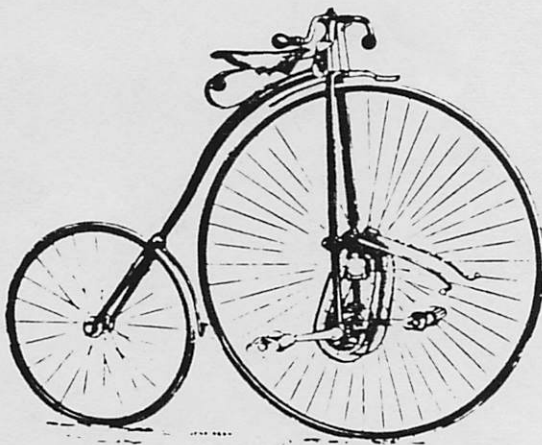

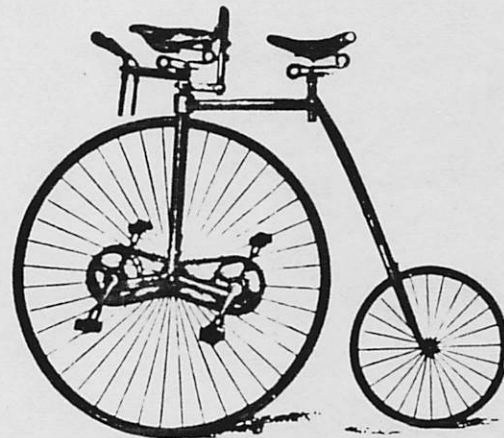
Your L.A.W. membership - don't leave home without it.
