clothes, and fully loaded bikes. They're out early in the morning and late at night. Some fly solo while others ride in large groups. And they all tend to don the eye-catching elastic

uniform behind the acronym.

Countless films have explored cycling as a professional sport, and the athletes that excel within it. But *MAMIL*, a new documentary out of Australia, offers a fresh perspective by introducing us to the everyday dads (and other men) who happen to be cycling diehards.
