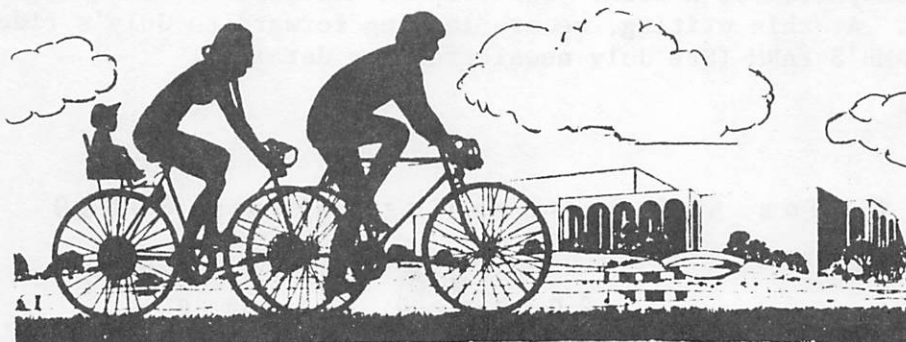

- August 30 Wood Oaks Junior High School, Sanders Road, Northbrook



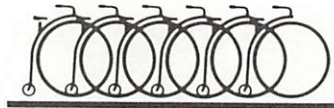
