Wayne was in charge of water, Gator Aid and overseeing the complete operation of the rest stop. Wayne does a fantastic job.




nia crab, shrimp, tuna, eel, vegetable, cucumber and spicy tuna.

Chicagoland Gets Large Portion of Governor's Bikeway Grannts!

Illinois Bikeway Grants provide up to 50% of the total cost of bike projects to local governments. The Department of Natural Resources administers the program. It received 51 applications seeking \$7.2 million for bike path projects. Here are 13 of the Chicagoland communities that received grants:

Chicago DOT: \$104,700Chicago Park Dist: \$200,000

Cook County FPD: \$265,000Frankfort: \$200,000

Frankfort: \$200,000Gurnee: \$200,000

Lake County DOT: \$200,000

McHenry County: \$200,000Naperville: \$200,000

• Oswegoland Park Dist: \$200,000

Rolling Meadows: \$37,500

Roselle: \$158,800
Tinley Park: \$80,000
Will County: \$200,000

The next round of bike path grants will be accepted from Jan 1 through Mar 1, 1999. Grants are limited to \$200,000, but money for purchasing land and right-of-ways is unlimited. From more




