# St. Patrick's Day Ride: Sunday, March 20, 2022

Scott was successful in reserving Wauconda High School. He will follow up with the venue and provide more ride details and event needs. Scott will also handle the ride guide, which is expected to come out at the end of March, or early April. Johannes is working to finalize the required insurance certificate for the event. The board needs to confirm equipment/goods in storage.

Food/beverage; need to determine if there are any food restrictions. The ride will require two shifts of volunteers; roughly 15-17 volunteers per shift, 30-35 total. The board is optimistic that the Wheelmen will be excited to participate in the 2022 event.

#### Harmon Hundred: Sunday, September 11, 2022

The Wilmot location has been secured. Debbie to talk with Eric after January 1<sup>st</sup> to reserve the two (2) rest stops, Eagle and Kaskin Park. Johannes is working on the insurance certificate. The ride will require two shifts of volunteers; roughly 80 total volunteers required. It was agreed that we will use the January 6th club meeting to talk about the event and secure a Chairman, discuss roles, and drum up excitement for volunteers.

Pactimo will guarantee sizing with a 100% return/exchange policy. Need design by late February or early March in order to be ready for the 2022 season. Designs will be shared for feedback and finalization. MJ to work on the member payment process, sizing, etc.
